We want to include everyone who would like to share their information!

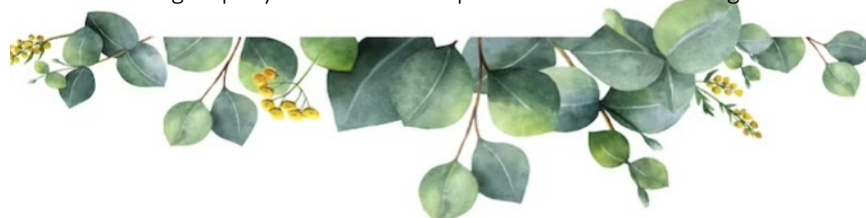
