Verse 3:

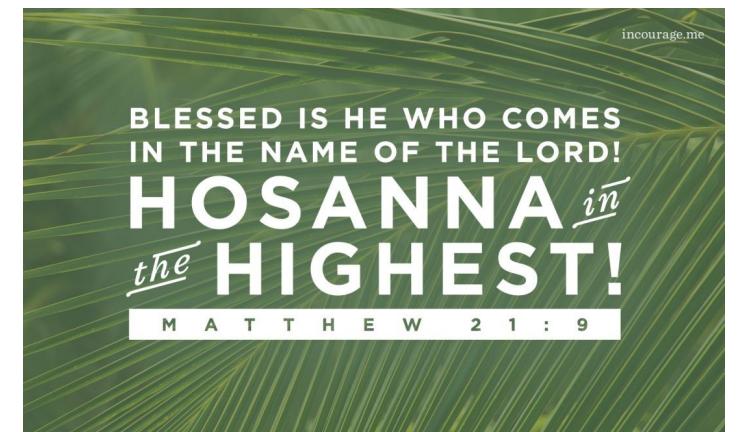
Now I've giv'n to Jesus ev'rything;
